

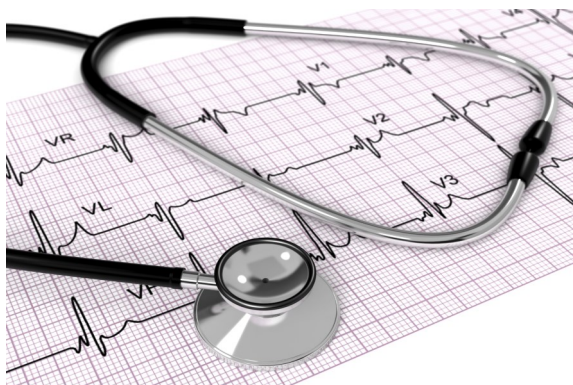
ACUTE CARDIAC CARE COURSE

COURSE SUMMARY

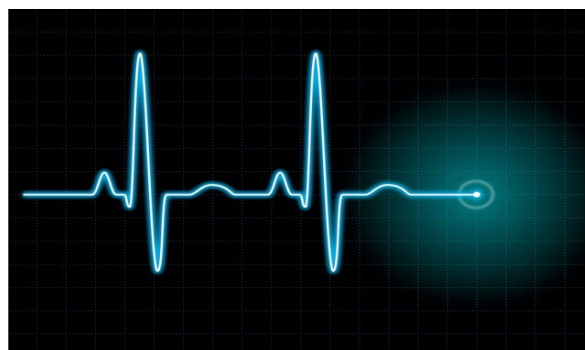
- Clinically focused course for undergraduate and postgraduate health professionals.

- Develop introductory clinical knowledge related to treatment modalities for acute coronary syndrome.
